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DREAMM International Pilot Workshop Materials

The DREAMM International Pilot Workshop was an opportunity for participating project partners and guests to explore and evaluate the feasibility of the three DREAMM Toolkits' content and design for stakeholders outside DREAMM wishing to make use of included tools during future projects and programmes concerning migration and integration in their national and local contexts. But it also enabled them to experience key pivotal concepts integrated in DREAMM's implementation through short, but effective presentations of the expertise each individual project partner brought to the DREAMM scenario; knowledge and skills that when pooled together aided all the beneficiaries involved reach DREAMM's ultimate target.

To bring together the DREAMM International Pilot Workshop, three categories of materials were used:

Workshop presentation tools:

(a set of visuals used to promote the two-day event, inform participants about what is going to take place during the event, and attest participants' attendance and participation during the event)

Both blinc (DE) and die Berater (AT) chose to give a semi-structured oral presentation each concerning (i) the fostering of open collaborative learning and assessing competences gained and (ii) the design and implementation of Joint Community Actions. This decision was in line to the agreement reached among all project partners to use the presentation mode that best suited their preferred learning patterns.

Toolkits' evaluation tools:

(a pack consisting of the three toolkits aimed at the preparation of Lead-Mentors, Mentors and Migrants together with their corresponding evaluation sheets, and a set of reflective questions meant to guide participants in evaluating the toolkits' initial content and design and offering recommendations for the production of more clear, concise, user-friendly toolkits)

The DREAMM project planning, implementation, and execution tools listed above can help prospective stakeholders investing focus, time and energy in migration and integration organise and manage an improvement project/programme, test various iterations for a project/programme, and successfully track a project/programme's tasks and components from start to completion.
